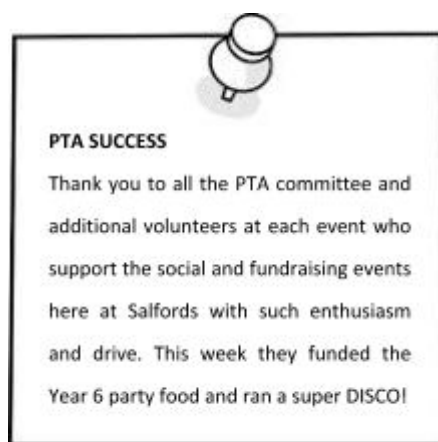
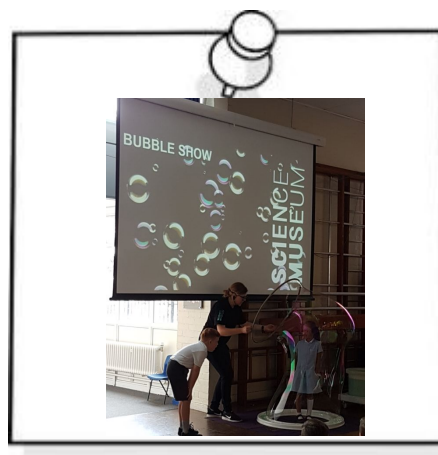
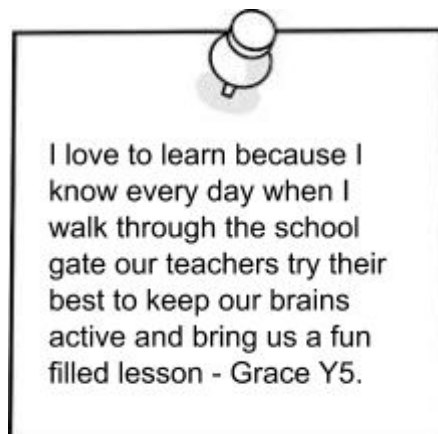
TIMETABLES

After the summer break we are introducing a new timetable for the children, which ensures sufficient curriculum time for the core and foundation subjects in the National Curriculum. This includes additional time for mental maths and handwriting and spelling skills. Every minute counts in schools - from 8.35am each day the children will be undertaking class mental maths activities to sharpen and rehearse their skills - lateness is unacceptable and parents have a duty to ensure their child is in school on time, before 8.50am.

ENTRANCE & EXIT DOORS

From September the doors to the two EYFS classes will be open, and then 3 other entry points will be manned by staff:

- Toucan





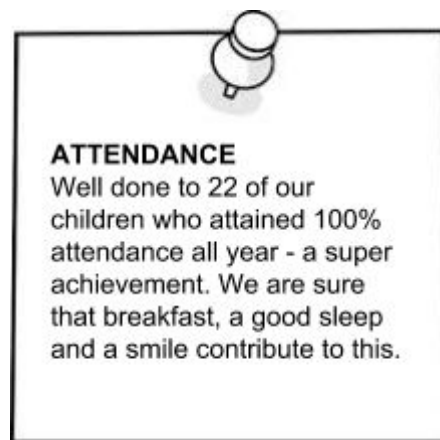
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- Parrot

At the end of the day, exit from school will be via:

- EYFS: own classroom doors
- Year 1: own classroom doors
- Year 2: Toucan door to large playground
- Year 3: Kingfisher door to large playground
- Year 4: Kingfisher door to large playground
- Year 5: own classroom doors via path
- Year 6: own classroom doors via path



Children in Years 4, 5 & 6 are only permitted to walk home when we have written consent from parents - this needs to be given to the office.
