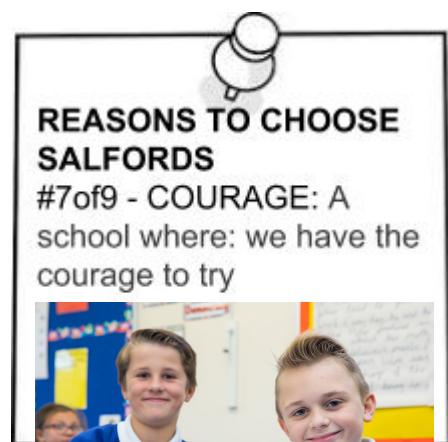
## HOUSE CAPTAINS
